



Current guidelines for all visitors

Mercy Circle welcomes all residents to spend time with their families and friends during one-hour indoor visits.

For the first time, fully vaccinated residents and their close relatives and friends can touch and hug when all wear a well-fitted mask and sanitize their hands before and after an encounter.

Contact LifeEnrichment@MercyCircle.org 48 hours in advance to schedule visits from 1pm until 4pm on Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays for two visitors age 12 and older from the same household. If another time is more convenient, ask to schedule it or a virtual visit. Mercy Circle also encourages compassionate care visits when they help residents.

If a visitor experiences symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19 within three days of being on campus, immediately call 773-253-3627 so Mercy Circle can complete contact tracing.

All visitors must

- Be screened over the phone for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 no more than 24 hours prior to visit
- Provide personal contact information to facilitate contact tracing
- Arrive wearing a face mask covering both nose and mouth
- Wash or sanitize their hands
- Practice social distancing; use designated entrances and exits
- Refrain from consuming food and beverages as well as sharing phones and tablets
- Comply with Chicago's travel advisories
