



Current precautions to mitigate the spread of COVID-19

All residents now can gather for communal dining, small group activities and Mass in our Chapel, as well as indoor and outdoor visits with guests. Please read *Visitor Guidelines* posted on our website for information about planning visits.

Residents also can leave our campus to visit family and friends and, under most circumstances, are not quarantined upon return.

Even though the majority of Mercy Circle residents and staff members are fully vaccinated against the virus, all residents, employees and visitors must comply with these precautions to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. They include

- Staying home if experiencing symptoms of or been exposed to the virus
- Monitoring yourself for symptoms of the virus and requesting a rapid test if you experience any symptoms or may have been exposed to COVID-19
- Participating in pre- and on-site screening
- Wearing a face mask that covers both your nose and mouth
- Practicing six-foot social distancing in all situations, especially entering and exiting common areas now clearly marked to facilitate distancing
- Washing your hands regularly using soap and water or sanitizer
- Conforming to Chicago's travel advisories
- Avoiding large crowds and unnecessary trips
