



Current guidelines for all visitors

Mercy Circle residents welcome family and friends for in-person visits between 10am and 8pm seven days a week. Because our residents and staff members comply with our vaccination policy, residents can enjoy daily life here.

As we see more cases of COVID-19 in Chicago and across Illinois, we appreciate your cooperation when you visit Mercy Circle as we continue to adhere to our basic safety practices here to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

Our requirements are guided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, as well as the Illinois and Chicago Departments of Public Health.

Before you visit, please

- Stay home not only if you have a positive test result for COVID-19 but also if you have a cold, the flu or any kind of transmissible virus
- Arrive wearing a tight-fitting KN95 or surgical mask that covers both your nose and mouth
- Register near the Reception Desk by using our new Accushield kiosk to enter your contact information, which is stored by phone number for quick reference for future visits; to answer a few questions about your status regarding COVID-19; and to have your temperature taken
- Ask for a surgical mask if you do not have one
- Wear your mask in all common areas
- Observe six-foot social distancing
- Sanitize your hands, especially before and after touching a resident
- Comply with testing and quarantine guidelines outlined in the travel advisory updated weekly by the City of Chicago

If you experience symptoms or test positive for COVID-19 within three days of visiting Mercy Circle, call 773-253-3627 so we can complete contact tracing.
