SUBJ One Resident in Skilled Nursing Care Tested Positive for COVID-19

Today when we tested all residents on the third floor, a resident in our skilled nursing care community, who is asymptomatic, received a positive outcome for COVID-19. This resident is isolated in the person's suite and our staff members wear appropriate PPE and take other precautions when providing care.

The third floor dining room remains open and skilled nursing care residents are encouraged to participate in activities. We are grateful to all staff members, residents and visitors because, at Mercy Circle, everyone continues to wear a mask in common areas; washes their hands; and observes social distancing when in crowded places.

While we welcome guests to all areas of our community, we ask them to review the *Visitor Guidelines* on our website before visiting and to register at the reception desk when they arrive here.

While the incidences of COVID-19, other viruses and the flu are decreasing, please stay home if you are experiencing any symptoms associated with them.
