On Wednesday, a full-time server, who was working in our dining room for assisted living residents, began to experience symptoms upon returning home from work. Our staff member took a COVID-19 test and it was a positive result. Last night Mercy Circle confirmed that outcome. This person only will return to Mercy Circle in accordance with CDC guidelines. Please respect this staff member's privacy.

Beginning today, all residents in assisted living will be tested twice a week. And staff members in all of our communities also will be tested twice a week.

Daily life will continue as usual at Mercy Circle and we encourage all residents to enjoy meals in the dining rooms, activities and attending Mass.
