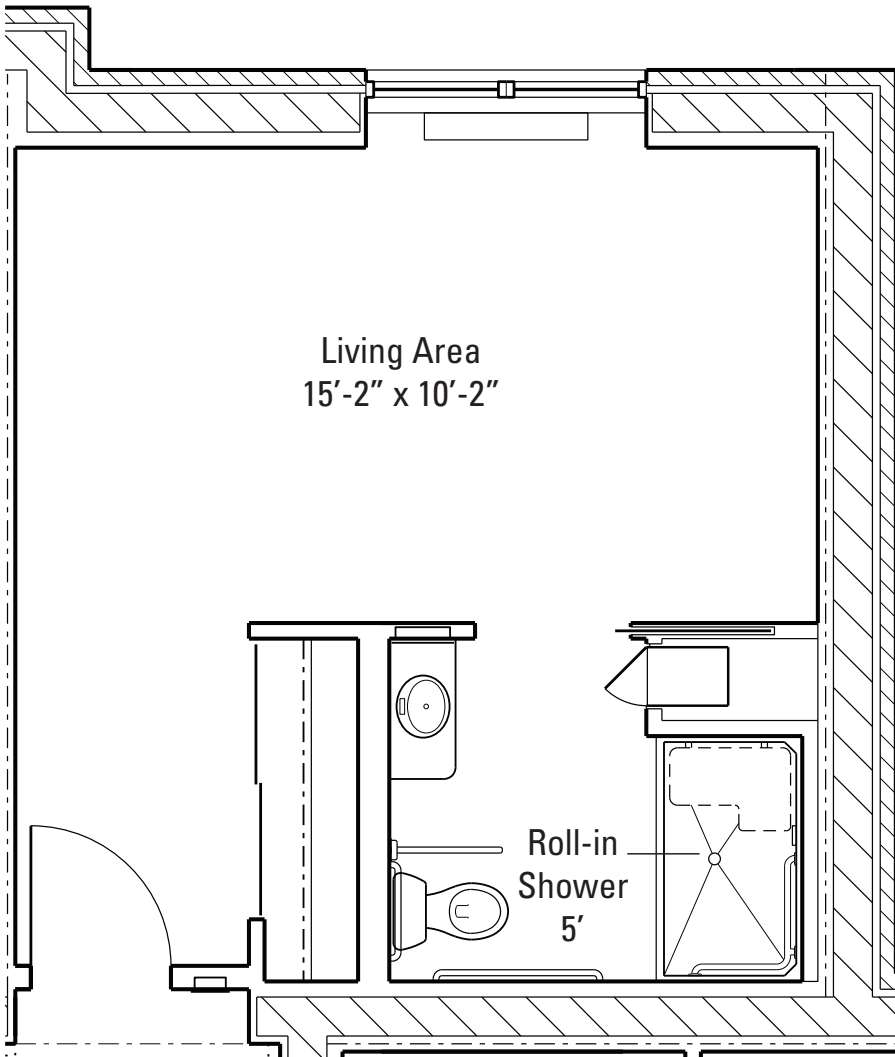


Baggot Street
